

Repeat this declaration out loud to yourself at least once every day until the Holy Spirit releases you. Ask the Spirit to speak to your spirit, and whenever something seems to "light up" your spirit, ask the Lord what to do with that. He may lead you to memorize a verse, or write it on a card and carry it with you, etc. Meditate on that until you know it is established in you.

My Declaration of Faith

Heavenly Father, I choose to believe what your Word says about me (Isaiah 40:8) rather than my carnal thoughts and feelings (2 Corinthians. 10:4). My unbelief has been sin (Romans 14:23).

Lord Jesus, thank you for loving me enough to die on the cross for my sins (Romans 5:8). There is, therefore, now no condemnation to me because I am in you (Romans 8:1). Every sin, past - present - future, has been forgiven (Ephesians 1:7) and cleansed (I John 1:7) by your blood. Your love for me is perfect (I John 4:18); therefore, I have nothing to fear. Thank you that nothing can touch me unless it is filtered through you, and all things will work for my good and your glory (Romans 8:28). Your love for me is unconditional (John 15:9) and everlasting (Jeremiah 31:3). I open my heart and life to your love; flow that love through me (Romans 5:5).

You know everything about me (Psalms 139:1-4) and yet you have accepted me just as I am in the beloved (Ephesians 1:6). You made me unique and special to fulfill your plan (Ephesians 2:10). Thank you for my body, my abilities, my parents which you designed as a part of your perfect plan (Psalms 139:14). Thank you for the Holy Spirit who lives within me to empower me to obey you (Ephesians 3:20). Thank you that I am complete in you (Colossians 2:10). You have given me all spiritual blessings in Christ (Ephesians 1:3). Your strength is adequate for every task; your grace is sufficient for every trial (2 Corinthians 12:9). I can do all things through you, Lord Jesus (Philippians 4:13). Thank you that you will perfect in me your plan (I Thessalonians 5:23-24). You are faithful even when I am not (2 Timothy 2:13). You have promised never to leave me (Hebrews 13:5). Even now you are changing me bit by bit into your image (2 Corinthians 3:18). I will not be foolish by comparing myself with others (2 Corinthians 10:12,5).

Father, how good it is to be your child. I belong! (I John 3:1) That makes me your responsibility (John 15:16). I give myself completely to you. Whatever is accomplished in and through my life, you'll have to do it (John 15:5; Philippians 2:13). Thank you for the confidence that you will (Philippians 1:6). Praise, praise be to you!
